East's Junior Development Program

The Easts Junior Development Program is a structured system that encourages Junior golfers of all levels and ages. The Program runs on most Fridays of the year and also encompasses School Holiday Clinics depending on demand.

Parental supervision at any level is not necessary however is encouraged for Juniors of any age until they become comfortable with their surroundings.

The Maitland Junior Development Program is a service to golf provided by the Maitland On Course Golf Factory. When thinking of your golf equipment needs please support the Shop that operates the Program.

Progression through the Junior Program is as follows.

Introduction to Golf & Advanced Clinics

A Junior Golf Clinic that incorporates Introduction and Advanced players, is conducted on most Fridays from 3:45pm to 4:45pm.

The Introduction Clinic as the name suggest introduces young golfers to the game and covers the basics of the full swing, short game and the etiquette of golf.

The Advanced Clinic works on more advanced movements in the golf swing. This Clinic provides ongoing support for Juniors who have progressed to the 9 and 18 hole Competition levels.

The cost of both Clinics is just \$5 and is open to any junior aged 5 to 18 years old. All equipment is supplied courtesy of the Maitland On Course Golf Factory.

9 and 18 Hole Competitions

Once a certain stage has been attained at the Introduction Level Juniors then progress to a 9 Hole Competition.

The 9 Hole Competition is played on Sundays and commences as per the schedule set out on the next page. Players need to book in 15 minutes before the scheduled start time to be included in the draw.

The cost of the 9 Hole Competition is only \$5 for a Junior or Cadet Member or \$9 for Visitors.

Once a handicap of 45 has been achieved in the 9 Hole Competition Junior players may graduate to the 18 Hole Competition.

The 18 Hole Competition commences as per the schedule set out on the next page. Players need to book in 15 minutes before the scheduled start time to be included in the draw.

The cost of the 18 Hole Competition is only \$ 8 for a Junior or Cadet Member or \$12 for Visitors.

Once a handicap of 36 has been achieved in the 18 Hole Competition Junior players may graduate to full Junior Membership and gain an AGU handicap.

MyGolf

MyGolf is Golf Australia's national Junior introductory program to develop and promote participation in golf. The Maitland On Course Golf Factory is affiliated with the program and parents can either register on line or through the Professional Shop.

Equipment Needs

Golf clubs and the correct specifications that they need to be is often a confusing issue, especially for young golfers who seem to be growing everyday. There are a few considerations when fitting golf clubs, but once these are overcome it is pretty easy to get the clubs that are right for you.

A scale used by qualified Golf Professionals that measures a golfers fingertip to the ground determines the length of golf clubs required by a player. When a golfer is addressing the ball correctly and once clubs have been fitted there is never a problem as to the length of a club.

Shaft flex can be broken down into to Junior, Ladies, A Flex, Regular, Stiff and Extra Stiff. One of these flexes suits everybody depending on the speed of their swing. The kick point of the shaft then helps determine the height that a shot will fly.

Grip thickness is a big variable, but is easily adjusted by qualified Golf Professionals. The thickness required changes from person to person depending on a scale of finger length to palm size. Everybody is different.
