On Saturday 1st July saw a field of 219 golfers compete in Toro Australia Monthly Mug - Stableford Competition.

The Monthly mug winners across the grades were Keith Shaw, Matt Gordon and Matt Godsell, congratulations to all.

“A” Grade was taken out by Keith Shaw with 40 points on the count back from Mark Caves and Matt Moroney. In 4th spot was Phil Oswald with 39 points followed closely by Brent Matthews with 38 points.

“B” Grade was taken out by Matt Gordon with 39 points. Runner up was Kevin Mills with 38 points on the count from Shane Redman. This was then followed by Richard Stewart with 37 points and Barry Hawkins with 36 points.

“C” Grade was taken out by Matt Godsell with a great score of 41 points. Runner up was Mark Langford with 39 points on the count back from Dylan Cawsey. This was closely followed by John Callen with 38 points and big hitting Tony Bennett with 36 points.
